Room Set-Up

Here are some suggestions to optimize your event with Mike Rayburn's presentation:

- 1. Hold the event in the smallest room which will comfortably hold all your attendees. A closer atmosphere makes for a much better energy and crowd dynamic. The key is to have as little open space as possible.
- If the event will be held in a ballroom or similar room be sure to have the stage as close to the audience as is reasonably possible. You don't want a large space between the stage and the first row. Closer proximity makes for a better connection between performer and audience.
- 3. If the audience is seated at tables, set the tables as close together as possible, allowing of course for walking and servers, as this, again, creates a better energy in the room.
- 4. When introducing Mike, please use the introduction provided on the website and refrain from reading Mike's bio, as this is not an introduction.
